Télé-Québec launches a new observational documentary series beginning November 19

Politics is an omnipresent force in the public sphere. But what do we really know about the day-to-day of the men and women who commit to careers as politicians?

Télé-Québec presents ***Nos élus***, Thursdays at 8 pm **beginning November 19**. This new documentary series produced by **Taïga Média** and directed by **Louis Asselin** throws open the doors of **Quebec's National Assembly**, revealing the outstanding work of our parliamentarians. This one-of-a-kind television event presents a layered, subtle exploration of the human side of politics.

The controversies and clashes of the democratic arena often obscure the human qualities and commitment of the women and men who dedicate their lives to the common good. Over the course of the four episodes, audiences will be treated to a different perspective on these people whose motivation to go into politics is above all their fellow citizens, because they share their concerns and seek to further worthy causes.

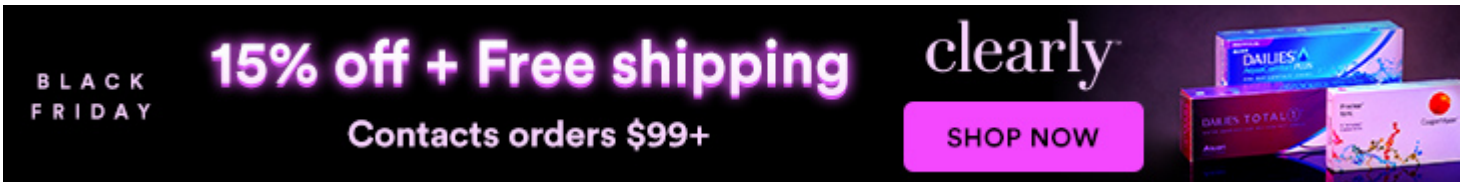
