To date, this year's 2Play shows have been performed 68 times and seen by over 7200 students. Bringing theatre to communities near and far, the 2Play team is thrilled to bring these incredible shows home to Geordie's Montreal audiences for four public performances.

So why does a self-described “extremely average 16-year-old girl” interrupt her school’s production of *Romeo and Juliet* to declare that something about its definition of love feels inadequate? Gill is processing the death of her Grandma, her parent’s impending divorce, and she has been cast as the minor role of Balthazar in *R and J*, while her crush, Qasim, is cast as *Romeo*.
