Description

The 10th Classica Festival will be held under the theme *From Wolfgang to Amadeus*

May 26, 2021

For its 10th edition, **Festival Classica** invites the public to come and enjoy more than twenty live indoor concerts that will be held from May 29 to June 22, 2021, at the [Paroisse catholique de Saint-Lambert Church](#). For its closing event, the Festival welcomes the **Orchestre Métropolitain** and its conductor **Yannick Nézet-Séguin**, who will perform one of Mozart's most celebrated masterpieces, the *Great Mass in C minor for soloists, chorus and orchestra* (K. 427/417a). To be able to accommodate more festival spectators while respecting sanitary measures, the Festival has reserved the [Eric-Sharp arena](#) in Saint-Lambert for this concert, which is already sold out.
